Of course the summer term is one of the most significant in the school year with assessments taking place for the majority of the children. Year 1 will complete the phonics check, Year 2 will undertake the SATs for Key Stage 1 which are national tests marked in school, Year 4 complete the multiplication check and of course Year 6 undertake the KS2 SATs which again are national test but they are sent away to be marked with results coming into school in mid July.

We make the testing process as stress free as we can for the children but these tests are important and it is vital that your child is in school for them.

We will send more information out as we receive it in school and nearer to the time.

Before the Easter holidays we noticed one or two of the children in Years 5 and 6 were wearing a bit of make-up to school and jewellery was also becoming more common.
