What is Tax-Free Childcare?

Tax-Free Childcare is a government scheme to support working parents with childcare costs.

For every £8 you pay in, the government will pay in an extra £2. You can get up to £2,000 per child per year, or £4,000 for disabled children.

You can use Tax-Free Childcare to pay for:

- · Childminders,
- Nurseries and nannies
- After school clubs
- Playschemes
- Home care workers working for a registered home care agency

If eligible, you set up an online childcare account which you can use to pay your childcare provider directly.

Apply for Tax-Free Childcare

Eligibility criteria

You (and your partner, if you have one) need to be working and each earn **national minimum** wage. To be eligible you'll need to earn the equivalent of 16 hours/week at the national minimum wage for your age group.

You can use Tax-Free Childcare at the same time as:

- 15 hours free childcare
- 30 hours free childcare

You can't use it with:

- Universal Credit
- Tax Credits
